TRAINING SERVICES

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Types of WIOA Training Include:

On-The-Job Training (OJT),
Educational Training (GED),
Occupational Skills Training

To qualify for training services an individual must be determined as needing training to do the following:

Retain their current employment; or

Gain new employment

ON-THE-JOB TRAINING

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The OJT program was designed to stimulate the economy and develop skilled workers for employers.

The WIOA reimburses employers up to 75% of a trainee's wages during the period of time needed to proficiently train them for the job.

The Advantages of the OJT Program are:

Training is tailored to what the company is looking for;

The employer makes the training decisions;

Better trained employees; and

The trainee can get a feel for the company environment.

TRAINING CLUSTERS


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Training sectors are occupations that are grouped together into a category (cluster) and approved by the Trident Workforce Development Board for training.


The Approved Clusters are:

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Supportive Services

Supportive Services are available provided the participant meets the requirements set by the local Workforce Development Administration, the service provider and the case manager.

Supportive Services are based on emergency situations and are not a guarantee.

Follow-up services are provided to WIOA participants for 12 months by WIOA staff members. During this time the WIOA staff will:

- Track your Employment Success; and
- Assist with job placement and job referrals as needed.

Follow-Up Services:

Participants are **REQUIRED** to stay in contact with follow-up staff for a full 12 months
